Ministry of High Education of the Arab Republic of Egypt is offering for the Georgian students five scholarships to study Arabic language for the academic year 2013-2014

The general terms of scholarships are the following:

- 1. The scholarship covers tuition and admission fees, and a monthly allowance of 16 LE. Students will receive first grant of the same amount upon their arrival. Accommodation and transportation (air ticket) are not included and should be covered by participants.
- 2. Each participant should submit the following documents:
 - Birth certificate
 - High school diploma legalized by the Georgian Ministry of Foreign Affairs, provided that it's date not more than 2 years ago
 - Six personal photographs
 - A copy of the passport
 - Medical certificate legalized by the Georgian Ministry of Health assuring that participant
 has no HIV- liver diseases (all of the above mentioned documents should be legalized by
 the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Georgia). At the same time kindly be informed that the
 student will pass be obliged to return back to by his own expense.
- 3. The student must be Georgian citizen and not to have any of his parents with Egyptian nationality and not to have any of relatives studying in these scholarships.
- 4. The wife of the married student is allowed to accompany her husband but will have no rights to benefit from any scholarships funded by the Egyptian side.
- 5. The student has no right to work during the time of the scholarship.
- 6. It is not allowed for the student to change the scholarship after arrival.
- 7. The student shouldn't have been chosen before in any of the scholarships provided by the Arabic Republic of Egypt or has been rejected from any these scholarships for any reason.
