Performance Report of Ministry of Education, Science, Culture, and Sport of Georgia within Rural Development Strategy of Georgia 2017-2020 and Action Plan for 2019

Ministry of Education, Science, Culture and Sport of Georgia, within Rural Development Strategy of Georgia 2017-2020 and Action Plan for 2019 approved by the Government of Georgia on December 30, 2016, is presented in the fields of education, culture, and sport.

The 18 activities noted in the Action Plan for 2019 include providing various social services to rural people - in the fields of education, culture, sports, as well as the development of educational, cultural and sports spaces infrastructure and rehabilitation of cultural heritage sites.

Remarkably, the number of activities of the Ministry has decreased from 20 to 18 compared to previous years, as a result of the abolition of the structural unit of the Ministry - "Department of Youth Management Policy" and establishment of the LEPL "Youth Agency" according to the decision of the Government of Georgia. Consequently, 2 activities which were under the Ministry's competence until 2018 that were aimed at promoting youth in rural areas, shifted to the competence of the Youth Agency from 2019.

The activities under Ministry of Education, Science, Culture, and Sport of Georgia, out of the three Strategic Priority Areas of Rural Development Strategy (economy and competitiveness, social conditions and living standards, environmental protection and sustainable management of natural resources) are presented in two Priority Areas: 1. Economy and Competitiveness; 2. Social Conditions and Living Standards.

The estimated total budget for 18 activities carried out by the Ministry was **GEL** 105,998,000. During the reporting period, due December 31, 2019, the total actual spending was **GEL** 85,973,880.
